March 8, 2024 Meeting Recap and Other News

March 8, 2024, Meeting Recap

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. There were 35 people in attendance, including a new member Pete Doolittle. He mostly models 1/48-scale armor and aircraft. John mentioned that we have not yet signed a contract with the Wheatland Salem Methodist Church for holding our IPMS Regional Show in November. He wants to offer tables to other IPMS clubs to display their models. This would also provide an incentive for other club members to assist with model contest judging. For our Regional Show, it has been approved to do gold, silver, and bronze judging (Chicago rules) rather than first, second, and third as done for most IPMS Regional and National Shows.

Business cards were available that have the "save-the-date" for our show and information on our Facebook site. Our Facebook group site is listed as Butch O'Hare IPMS Model Club. Currently there are 108 members. Once you join, you can post photos of your models and so forth.

John brought in some of the Minicraft kits he recently obtained, including several aircraft models and a large Titanic model. Academy is going to be taking over Minicraft. Carl Knable the discussed his former association with Minicraft and discussed the rise and fall of the company. 




Bob Frysztak: The 1/96 USS Constitution continues, with scratch-made decals for the gangway planks and more sail work.

Kevin Stover: A 1/48 Dassault Rafale from Revell, built 15-20 years ago..








