February 9, 2024 Meeting Recap and Other News

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. There were 31 people in attendance; 13 of which paid their annual dues. John mentioned that the Mad City Modelers will hold their 28th Annual Contest in Madison, WI, on March 2. He would like to have flyers prepared for our November IPMS Regional Show to distribute at the Mad City Modelers' show. We also need to determine a theme for our show. Suggestions for a theme are welcome. Several in attendance voiced their opinion that it should not be based on a battle or other event that occurred 80 years ago during WWII (or even 110 years ago when WWI started). (Your humble secretary suggests something like "figures throughout history and prehistory," that encompasses a category other than just military armor and aircraft – why even John Frysztak could add a figure of Samuel Nicholson [the first commander of the USS Constitution] to his ship model!) John then mentioned that there is a possibility of holding our November Show at Hector's church. We could possibly get scouts to help set up tables. The facility at the church is nicer than the DuPage County Fairgrounds; however, we need to first determine whether the church is price prohibited.

Show and Tell was then held. The theme for tonight was "Anything Ford." Several members brought in their Ford vehicles and a few aircraft produced by Ford. Ihor even brought some military figures he painted of the "Ford brothers.

The theme for our March 8, 2024 meeting will be "NATO."



Chrome Spray from Revell. Looks amazing on the spoon, but Kevin has some concerns about its scuff/scratch resistance.








